

RESOLUTION NO. R-87-133

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF PISMO BEACH DESIGNATING
THE ANNIVERSARY HOUSE AS A HISTORICAL
LANDMARK OF THE CITY OF PISMO BEACH.

WHEREAS, John Price, arriving in Pismo Beach in the 1850's was one of the first settlers of the City of Pismo Beach; and,

WHEREAS, John Price built a framed structure on Rancho El Pismo in the City of Pismo Beach, therewith called the Anniversary House; and,

WHEREAS, the Anniversary House is the oldest standing structure in the City of Pismo Beach; and,

WHEREAS, the Anniversary House is a unique historical structure relating to the founding and development of the City of Pismo Beach; and,

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Beautification Commission has requested the City Council to consider the designation of the Anniversary House as a Historic Landmark of the City of Pismo Beach.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Pismo Beach designates the Anniversary House as a Historic Landmark of the City of Pismo Beach.




